Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge

The Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge is open from Term 2 and Langwarrin Park Primary School is excited to be participating.

The Challenge is open to all Victorian children from birth to Year 10 in recognition of the importance of reading for literacy development. It is not a competition; but a personal challenge for children to read a set number of books by the final week of Term 3, 16 September 2022.

Children from Prep to Year 2 are encouraged to read or 'experience' 30 books with their parents and teachers. Children from Year 3 to Year 6 are challenged to read 15 books. Children are encouraged to continue reading through the entire PRC and there is no limit at 100 books now so go for it!!

All children that meet the Challenge will receive a certificate of achievement signed by the Victorian Premier. All LPPS students are offered participation in the Challenge and will receive a username and password from their teacher this week.

Our library holds around 2,000 books that are part of the Premier's Reading Challenge indicated with a sticker on the spine. You can search our Library from home at library.langwarrinparkps.vic.edu.au and go to the Quick lists to find your child's level. We also encourage you to visit the local Frankston library online to borrow books. Check your books at home because chances are they may be on the list too.
