- Be rude, aggressive or harass anyone
- Speak in a threatening tone, either in person or over social media
- Send rude, confronting or threatening letters, emails, text messages or posts on social media
- Damage or vandalise property or the environment
- Make sexist, racist, sexually inappropriate or derogatory comments or behaviour, either in person or via the use of technology
- Use social media in a malicious manner
