Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge

Dear Parents,

The Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge commences from the first day of Term 2 and Langwarrin Park Primary School is excited to be participating once again. All LPPS students are offered participation in the Challenge and will receive a username and password from their teacher before the end of term.

The Challenge is open to all Victorian children from birth to Year 10 in recognition of the importance of reading for literacy development. It is not a competition, but a personal challenge for children to read a set number of books by Week 10 of Term 3, Friday 18th of September 2026.

Children from Prep to Grade 2 are encouraged to read or 'experience' 30 books with their parents and teachers, comprising of 20 Challenge books and 10 books of their choice. Children from Grade 3 to Grade 6 are challenged to read 15 books, comprising of 10 Challenge books and 5 books of their choice. Children are encouraged to continue reading through the entire PRC as there is no limit on the number of books you read. We will provide regular progress updates at our assemblies and in The Link. All children that meet the Challenge will receive a certificate of achievement signed by the Victorian Premier.

Our library holds around 3,000 books that are part of the Premiers' Reading Challenge booklist, these are indicated with a sticker on the books spine and found in our dedicated PRC section of the library. We also encourage you to visit your local library to borrow books that our library may not have. Remember to check your books at home too, as chances are they may be on the list!
